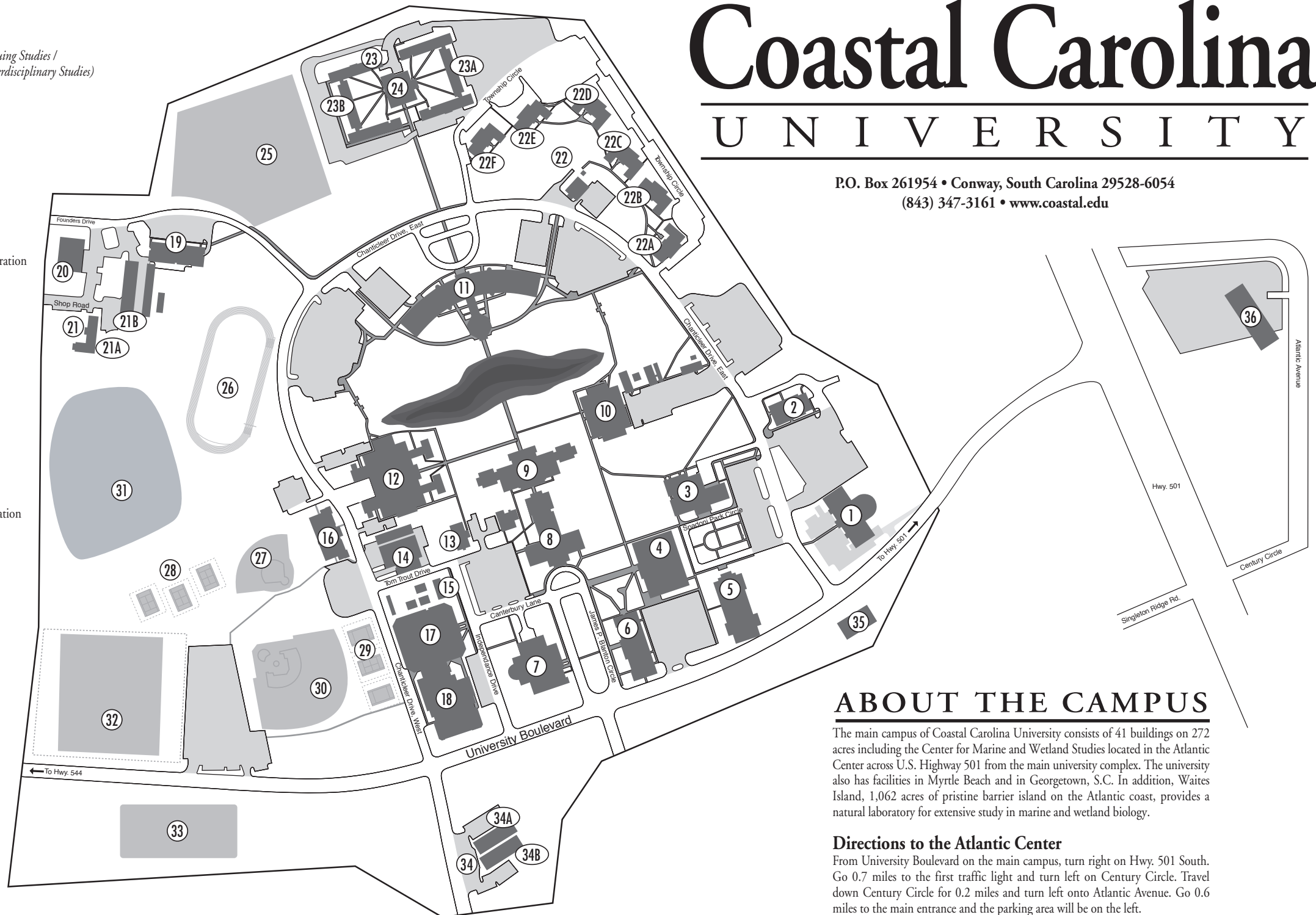

ABOUT THE CAMPUS

The main campus of Coastal Carolina University consists of 41 buildings on 272 acres including the Center for Marine and Wetland Studies located in the Atlantic Center across U.S. Highway 501 from the main university complex. The university also has facilities in Myrtle Beach and in Georgetown, S.C. In addition, Waite Island, 1,062 acres of pristine barrier island on the Atlantic coast, provides a natural laboratory for extensive study in marine and wetland biology.

Directions to the Atlantic Center

From University Boulevard on the main campus, turn right on Hwy. 501 South. Go 0.7 miles to the first traffic light and turn left on Century Circle. Travel down Century Circle for 0.2 miles and turn left onto Atlantic Avenue. Go 0.6 miles to the main entrance and the parking area will be on the left.
